TRANSPORTATION AND SCHEDULE OVERVIEW

UAIS SCHEDULE

The Utica Academy for International Studies will be implementing a new schedule and new transportation plan for the Academy’s third year. As we have grown, we have developed the capacity to more aptly meet the needs of our students. This means that we will continue to align with the high school day facilitating clubs, activities and involvement in the students’ base schools. However, with the advent of the IB Diploma Program offerings and the Theory of Knowledge Course, the UAIS will be utilizing a block schedule in the 2010-11 school year.

As such, students will have three courses a day in the first semester.

Students will meet for the same number of hours and minutes as the current schedule, but will meet in only three classes per day. Juniors will have three courses and the Theory of Knowledge (ToK) Course in the spring and then again in the fall to meet the IB Theory of Knowledge requirements. **THIS DOES NOT EFFECT THE START OR END OF THE SCHOOL YEAR OR THE START OR END OF THE DAY.** All UCS calendar dates remain the same.

The first day of class will be Tuesday, September 7, 2010.

The 2010-11 school=year will begin at 7:20 am and end at 2:11 pm.



TRANSPORTATION

The Utica Academy for International Studies Transportation plan has been explained through a number of letters and Emails. The following is a summary:

Stevenson Catchment: Pickup and drop-off will be in neighborhood. Students will ride buses along with Stevenson students and will be dropped at UAIS before buses continue onto Stevenson or after they have dropped them off. Neighborhood drop off locations will be posted on the UCS Transportation page.

Eisenhower Catchment: AM Pickup will be at Eisenhower (6:45 am), Shelby (6:57 am) or Beacontree Elementary (6:45 am) and evening drop off will be at neighborhood stops via transfer at Malow Jr. High or Shelby Jr. High. Neighborhood drop-off locations will be posted on the UCS Transportation page.

Utica Catchment: AM Pickup will be at Utica/Wiley (7:00 am) and Shelby Jr. High (6:57 am). Evening drop off will be at neighborhood stops via transfer at Malow Jr. High or Shelby Jr. High. Neighborhood drop-off locations will be posted on the UCS Transportation page.

Henry Ford II Catchment: AM Pickup will be at HFII (7:06 am) and Bemis Jr. High (7:04 am). Evening drop off will be at neighborhood stops via transfer at Malow Jr. High or Shelby Jr. High. Neighborhood drop-off locations will be posted on the UCS Transportation page.

Information on parking passes for Juniors is included in this packet. Juniors with appropriate driver's licensing and proof of ownership of a personal or family vehicle will be able to purchase a parking pass for \$25 at registration.
